GREEN TIPS

When making purchases, think of the provenance of the item, where and how it was made, how far it has travelled, whether it has contributed to depleting the earth of rare resources. For food, you can follow the **LOAF** principle, **L**ocal, **O**rganic, **A**nimal friendly and **F**airly traded.

For non-food, think of the same principles; is it local, was it made with organic products, was it fairly traded, and did it use rare resources, like water and minerals.

All these aspects help or hinder the preservation of the earth.

GREEN LIFE THOUGHTS

Recycle – Recycling should be the last resort. Recycling does reduce the rate in which we use natural resources, but it still uses a lot of energy for transporting and processing the items. Complete the loop by buying items made from recycled materials.
