## **GREEN ECO MATTERS**

## Sunday May 11th from 2 - 5pm

'Tewkesbury Big Clean'. This is a project coordinated by Bill Adie, who is very involved in the Tewkesbury Project Alley cat group. It is a plan to have a 'community clean up' on Sunday May 11th from 2 - 5pm - to undertake litter picking, weeding and general tidying up of the town prior to the Big Weekend. It is supported by Friends of the Earth, Boys Brigade, Girl Guides, and the Abbey and Holy Trinity Eco groups are looking to get involved. I wondered if it is something that Tewkesbury Methodist Church might be able to support? If so, would I be able to connect you up with Bill around this? (Or please do connect yourselves directly if you already know Bill!).

### 'Climate Resilience' Planning.

The Abbey Eco group and Holy Trinity Eco group are looking to plan a joint meeting in June/ July to discuss 'climate resilience' planning. This is thinking about how we might use our collective resources in times when Tewkesbury is affected by extreme weather (flooding, heat, cold) to support the wider community. The idea has come from reading the new Eco church survey and remembering how the communities responded in 2007. There is a feeling that it would be worth writing this down, so that should an extreme weather event occur (which sadly is increasingly likely), we have plans to respond.
