### DIRECTIONS

Take A38 out of Tewkesbury towards Worcester. Continue on the A38 over the A38/M50 intersection roundabouts and within 1/2 mile on A38 you will see the sign for **Stratford Bridge**.

**Cotswold Manor Residential Park** will be on your right. Continue on, past the **'Welcome to Worcestershire'** sign. Start signalling a left turn at this point and slow down.

Observe two black and white cottages one on each side of the road. Just **beyond them** and immediately **on your left**, (but after the cottage entrance with a long barn), is a long red brick wall which forms the frontage of Stratford Bridge House. Proceed to the far end of the wall, turning into the drive entrance, marked with a public footpath sign.

This will bring you down into the yard.

Please park on the grass area to your left as you enter the yard. Reversing onto the grass preferable for maximum parking arrangements. There is space for 8/9 cars.
