Medicines: Pain killers, Bandages + support aids for wrists, knees or ankles.

Candles + wax: new or old, damaged, stubs, broken - It does not matter. **Prefer NOT perfumed and not in containers.** It is all melted down to make small stoves & heaters with new wicks in Food Tins. (it is -15 degrees there) Amazon sells bags of wax bits if you have no candles.
