**February 20th Mary's Meals:** Mary's Meals provides life changing school meals to over 3 million children in some of the worlds poorest communities. The promise of a good meal brings hungry children into the classroom where they can gain an education and better opportunities for the future.

**February 27th Christian Aid:** For over 80 years Christian Aid has stood with the poorest in the world. They work in 29 countries, with people of all faiths and none, standing for dignity, equality and justice. When emergencies occur they can act immediately, save lives and support people in the long term.

**March 6th Big Space Cancer Appeal:** Big Space Cancer Appeal by Gloucestershire Hospitals NHS Trust. The first phase of the project is to build a new space at Cheltenham General Hospital to improve the environment inside and out for patients and staff. Existing facilities in the current Oncology Centre will also be upgraded as part of the second phase of the project.

**March 13th North Cotswold Foodbank:** North Cotswold Foodbank (Winchcombe) Helping local people in crisis. They supply three days emergency food and support local people who are referred to them in hardship.

**March 20th Air Ambulance:** Great Western Air Ambulance provides critical care for serious incidents covering all of Gloucestershire.

**March 27<sup>th</sup> Kaye's Home Nursing:** Kate's Home Nursing is a local charity employing registered nurses to care for people in their own homes through the last stages of illness offering support and care for the patient their families and carers.
