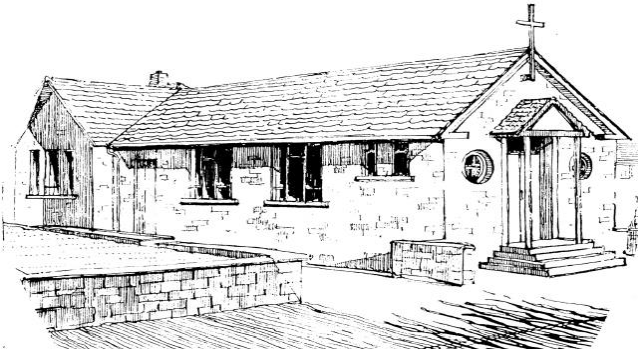


Welcome to Bishop's Cleeve Methodist Church
